What to believe

Evaluate your information sources

- Current
- Local
- Relevant
- CAUTION:
 - Studies are being published quickly, often without peer review
 - Watch out for "magical thinking" and unreliable online sources

- We don't know what the new normal will look like
- Consider the life cycle of a show
- Pre-production:
 - Programming
 - Design
 - Risk Assessment
 - Time, People, Money

Construction:

- Costumes
- Props
- Scenery
- Scenic Art
- Rigging
- Lighting, sound, projections

- Artists (actors, dancers, musicians etc.):
 - Rehearsal Hall
 - Warm-ups
 - Classes
 - Costume Fittings

- Load-in, Set-up and Tech Work
 - Scenery
 - Scenic Art
 - Rigging
 - Automation
 - Lighting, sound, projections
- Strike and Load-out (similar)

- Onstage Rehearsals and Performances
 - Backstage
 - Orchestra Pit
 - Dressing rooms
 - Green Room
 - Understudies/Swings
